Don Newman is Chair of **CANADA 2020** - a public policy forum for social and economic prosperity - and Senior Strategic Advisor to **Bluesky Strategy Group inc.**, a public affairs and communications firm.

He is also Senior Columnist with **iPOLITICS.ca**, a leading online political news service, and a sought-after political commentator, moderator and speaker.

He serves on the boards of Canada's National History Society, the new Science Media Centre of Canada, the Canadian Club of Toronto and the Canadian Committee for World Press Freedom Day; is Chair of the Jury for the 2011 Canadian Foreign Service Awards, and a judge of Canada's National Newspaper and Charles Lynch Awards.

For his contribution to Canada and public affairs journalism for over four decades, he was awarded the Order of Canada, a Gemini lifetime achievement award among other prestigious awards, honorary degrees from Queen's and Winnipeg universities, and made a life member of the Canadian Parliamentary Press Gallery.

As Senior Parliamentary Editor for CBC Television for over two decades, Don Newman anchored his own political affairs programs and numerous specials and live events, and helped launch Canada's first all news channel. He was also a foreign correspondent with CTV and CBC, reporting from Washington, London and the United Nations, and early in his career a reporter with The Globe and Mail and Winnipeg Tribune newspapers.
